Powers Creek Water Treatment Plant

The City of West Kelowna has an opening for an eight month student in the Water Engineering Technology field to gain valuable hands-on experience by completing a work term in our Public Works Department at the Powers Creek Water Treatment Plant.

Infrastructure maintenance and operation are key components of Public Works and plays a large part in asset management. The focus of this position will be to support Powers Creek Water Treatment Plant staff by performing a variety of tasks such as:

- Monitoring and testing water samples for proper chemical additions
- Record keeping and logs in the daily reports
- Repairs to plant equipment as needed
- General maintenance and other duties as required

Requirements:

- Current enrollment in a registered Water Engineering Technology program at a post-secondary institution
- Must be attending college or university during the last school term and returning to your studies in the subsequent academic year
- Demonstrated computer skills in Microsoft Office Suite (Outlook, Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access)
- Familiarity with SCADA and SCADA interfaces
- Excellent communication/interpersonal skills – verbal and written
- High attention to detail
- Physically fit in order to accomplish maintenance tasks
- A valid Class 5 driver's license

The student will work 8 months from beginning of May until end of December, 40 hours per week, 7:00am - 3:30pm, with an hourly rate of \$19.33 plus 4% vacation pay (wage under review). These positions may require shift work and/or including weekend shifts.

Information for Applicants: The City of West Kelowna has a COVID-19 Vaccination Policy that requires all employees to be fully vaccinated as a condition of hire and continued employment. Candidates who can establish that they cannot be fully vaccinated for a valid reason related to a protected ground under the British Columbia Human Rights Code may request an exemption.
